The 2026 Horse Fair takes place from 9 to 16 May

The Jerez Horse Fair has been declared a **Festival of International Tourist Interest** and is a must-see event for anyone wishing to experience one of the city's most authentic traditions.

The Horse Fair fills González Hontoria Park and the city with colour, art and joy.

The 2026 Horse Fair is dedicated to Jerez's designation as the Spanish Capital of Gastronomy 2026, and Gastronomy Day will be celebrated at the Fair on Tuesday 12 May.

Opening

The 2026 Jerez Horse Fair features a modern lighting system, marking a significant step forward in terms of energy efficiency, sustainability and safety. One of the key innovations to be introduced is LED lighting, which will replace traditional incandescent bulbs. This technology not only reduces energy consumption but is also more environmentally friendly, reinforcing the city's commitment to sustainability.

On Saturday 9, at 10.00 pm, the lights will be switched on from the Municipal Bandstand, an event that officially marks the start of the 2026 Horse Fair.

Following the switch-on, the sky will be lit up by a fireworks display specially designed for the occasion, combining light, rhythm and colour.



Horse and Carriage Parade

The Horse and Carriage Parade is one of the Fair's most distinctive traditions. From the second day of the Fair until the closing Saturday, between 1 pm and 7.30 pm, riders and horse-drawn carriages of all styles parade through the streets of the Fair venue in a unique display of elegance and majesty, arousing admiration and creating a grand spectacle.

The horse thus takes centre stage at the Jerez Fair, whose programme includes an extensive calendar of equestrian events that generate great excitement among enthusiasts from all over the world.

Visitors can hire horse-drawn carriages at a set rate per time and route, to enjoy an authentic Fair experience.



The *casetas* (marquees) are one of the most iconic symbols of the Feria and the place to meet up for a glass of Sherry, sample exquisite local cuisine and dance a few sevillanas. Inside them, you can really soak up and experience the festive atmosphere.

From an aesthetic point of view, a caseta is a metal structure covered with canvas, decorated with the typical 'farolillos' (paper lanterns) inside. However, in Jerez, there is a long-standing tradition of decorating and maintaining the *casetas*, both inside and out, with the construction of facades depicting monuments or typical landmarks of the city. It is also common for the *casetas* to adopt the traditional Andalusian aesthetic. Thus, it is frequent to see *casetas* that transport us to a typical country farmhouse, complete with farming implements and rural tools, as an allegory to the region's wine-making and livestock-rearing traditions. Another common style among the *casetas* is to take on the appearance of old communal courtyards, with large windows and a beautiful floral display of carnations, small carnations, gitanillas and geraniums.

Every year, the City Council organises a competition to reward the best *casetas* set up in the Real (the Fair venue), culminating in an award ceremony at the Municipal Pavilion.

PROGRAMME OF EVENTS FOR THE 2026 HORSE FAIR

The Horse Fair is an event offering a varied programme, allowing visitors to enjoy the best of both worlds. The equestrian events, which take place over several days at various locations across the city, include dressage, conformation and breeding competitions, showcasing the high quality and skill of the participants. These events allow visitors to enjoy top-level competitions, featuring a variety of breeds and disciplines, from classical to Vaquera dressage.

At the same time, the 'horse parade' returns to the fair venue: numerous horses and carriages, ridden and driven respectively by riders and coachmen, make their way leisurely along the avenues of the fair venue, decked out in their finest finery and adornments. This elegant, dynamic and colourful procession forms the fair's famous horse and carriage parade. On the Thursday of the fair, the best riders and horse-drawn carriages from the Horse Parade will be judged from the González Byass bandstand, followed by the awards ceremony, which will take place from 2.00 pm to 3.00 pm.

History of the Horse Fair

Having emerged from the horse trade in the Middle Ages, it continues to maintain close ties with the equine world, being the only fair that still hosts a major livestock and horse fair held in parallel with the main festival. The current fair originated at the beginning of the last century from the merger of the Dehesa de Caulina livestock fair and the public fair open to the general public, which featured bullfighting events.

The Jerez Horse Fair has distinctive features that make it unique. It is a fair with casetas (marquees) open to the public, where anyone can enjoy the music and the magnificent local cuisine. Similarly, the City Council encourages the decoration of the caseta through a competition that rewards the most original and beautiful design within the fair venue.

These elements, together with the Horse and Carriage Parade, the flamenco that can be heard in every corner of the González Hontoria, the Sherry and, above all, the joy, make the Jerez Fair a festival to be enjoyed with all five senses.

Held annually over the course of a week, the city is transformed into a space for socialising, culture and tradition, where joy and a festive atmosphere take centre stage. This celebration offers the chance to enjoy the most representative elements of Jerez: horses, flamenco and Sherry.

The fair has its origins in an old livestock market, evolving to become one of Andalusia's most iconic festivals, where the Purebred Spanish Horse of the Cartujana lineage takes centre stage



INFORMATION OF INTEREST

AMUSEMENT AREA

The 'Cacharritos' area is a favourite with the little ones. In addition to the wide range of rides, there are popular food stalls, tombola stands, shooting galleries and other games of skill where you can win all sorts of prizes.

The attractions are open from 1.00 pm until the early hours of the morning. On Tuesday 12 and the final Sunday, there are reduced prices on the attractions.

On Monday 11, Tuesday 12 and Wednesday 13, from 6.00 pm to 8.00 pm, there will be noise-free periods for people with particular sensitivity.

THE 'BEST CASETA' COMPETITION

On Monday 11 May, at 1.00 pm, the Municipal Pavilion will host the official prize-giving ceremony for the 2026 Horse Fair 'Best Caseta' Competition.

These prizes recognise the effort and creativity involved in showcasing traditional elements of Jerez through the decoration of the casetas.

The Fair is a showcase for ephemeral art where traditional aesthetics coexist with new forms of creative expression. Particular value is placed on the use of motifs related to the fair, such as horses, flamenco or vines, as well as references to Jerez's designation as the Spanish Capital of Gastronomy.

CHILDREN'S DAY

On Tuesday 12 May, Children's Day will be celebrated with a special offer allowing children to enjoy the fairground rides, popularly known as 'cacharritos', at reduced prices.

This day has become one of the most eagerly awaited events of the Fair, as it offers children the chance to experience the magic and excitement of the rides.

The price of the rides will be reduced, with the price for that day set as follows:

- Children's rides: €2.50
- Adult rides: €3.00
- Single-track rides with fewer than 16 seats: €4.00

GRANDCHILDREN'S DAY

Sunday 17 May is a special day marking the close of one of Jerez's most iconic celebrations. Although the Feria has ended, the festive atmosphere continues in the amusement park area, where discounts are offered to children on a day that pays tribute to the grandparents accompanying their grandchildren. With the aim of fostering intergenerational bonding, the amusement park will remain open throughout the day and the prices indicated for Children's Day will apply.

NOISE-FREE – ‘QUIET DAYS’

The 2026 Horse Fair is introducing these days with the aim of making it easier for people with Autism spectrum disorders, Asperger’s syndrome or any other condition that is exacerbated by noise to experience and enjoy the amusement park.

On Monday 11, Tuesday 12 and Wednesday 13 May, ‘Noise-Free Days’ will be held between 6.00 pm and 8.00 pm. During this time, all establishments and attractions will not play music, broadcast adverts or use any form of sound amplification.

Women’s Day at the Fair is an **opportunity to celebrate and highlight the contribution of generations of women who have made this festival a symbol of identity and community spirit**, whilst reinforcing the values of equality, respect and diversity that inspire the model of an open and inclusive Jerez Fair.

The traditional gathering with Jerez’s women’s associations will take place at the Municipal Pavilion from 1.00 pm to 3.00 pm.

JEREZ-STYLE WIDE-BRIMMED HAT DAY

On Thursday 14 May, the presentation ceremony for the 2026 Jerez Wide-Brimmed Hat Award will take place at 2.00 pm at the Municipal Pavilion.

The Jerez Wide-Brimmed Hat Award was established in 2009 with the aim of promoting the atmosphere and traditional customs of the Jerez Fair.



DIASPORA DAY

Friday 15 May marks Diaspora Day. The Jerezanos de la Diáspora association will hold a toast to celebrate Jerez's designation as the Spanish Capital of Gastronomy at the Municipal Pavilion.

DAY FOR 'THE RAINBOW TOAST TO DIVERSITY'

The Rainbow Toast is even more special at this year's 2026 Horse Fair, as the Jereslesgay Association marks a quarter of a century of LGBTIQAP+ activism in Jerez.

The traditional Rainbow Toast will be held on Wednesday 13 May at 6.00 pm at the Jereslegay caseta, number 144.

DAY FOR ELDERLY PEOPLE FROM RURAL NEIGHBOURHOODS AND DISTRICTS

Tuesday 12 May will be the day for elderly people from rural neighbourhoods and districts.

The "Caseta del Mayor" will be reserved entirely for this group and transport will be organised to bring them to the Fair venue from the various neighbourhoods.

Seniors will be treated to a special menu accompanied by a musical performance from 4.30 pm at the Municipal Pavilion.

YOUTH RECREATION AREA

The area to the north of González Hontoria Park will be set up as a leisure activity zone, intended primarily for young people.

Safe points are set up in public spaces, specifically within the fairground, with the aim of ensuring women's safety and preventing sexist assaults.

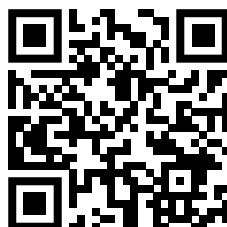
