- ➤ Taxes and Social Insurances are deducted from gross salary (around 35%) as student with a health insurance covering also the time you are working in Germany, you will have only few deductions.
- > Companies offer accommodation, most of them for reasonable payment
- > Many companies offer food during the shifts, sometimes for payment, sometimes for free
- > Some employers refund the travel expenses or a part of it at the end of the contract
